



2024 WWE Money in the Bank results, recap, grades: CM Punk thwarts McIntyre again, Solo Sikoa pins Cody Rhodes

Description

The 15th Annual WWE's **Money in the Bank** pay-per-view was full of surprises and dramatic turns. The WWE champion lost for the first time. This happened when two wrestlers won the Money in the Bank ladder matches. Also, one competitor changed the game in the world heavyweight **championship** match.

One wrestler began the event by winning the Men's Money in the Bank match. He used his winning chance during the match between two other wrestlers. However, another wrestler entered the game and **thwarted** the winner's plan. This led to a situation where one competitor could defeat the other. This prevented the original winner from taking the world title. Also, now another wrestler can't fight for the title as long as the current titleholder holds it.

Fans look forward to the next WWE event, **SummerSlam**. They can't wait to see matches like the WWE champion vs. another competitor, the original winner vs. another wrestler, and the titleholder vs. another **competitor**.

In a major twist, one wrestler was the one to change the game for his team against three other competitors. One wrestler took the win for his team after hitting another with a **signature move**.
