# Aaron Sorkin Explores 'West Wing' Reboot Post White House Visit

## Description

Aaron Sorkin exhibited overt emotional resonance during his recent visit to the White House, where he commemorated the 25<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the critically acclaimed series "The West Wing."
