



Adult entertainment industry files lawsuit over law mandating age verification for pornographic websites

Description

Adult entertainment industry challenges Indiana law requiring porn sites to verify users' ages. The law, signed by Governor Eric Holcomb in March, allows legal action if explicit material is accessible to minors. Similar laws are in place in Texas, Arkansas, Kansas, Louisiana, Mississippi, Montana, Oklahoma, Utah, and Virginia. Supporters claim these laws protect children from online pornography, while opponents argue they are vague and invade privacy. The Free Speech Coalition, filing a complaint in federal court, deems the Indiana law unenforceable and unconstitutional. They seek an injunction before the July 1 enforcement date. Indiana Attorney General Todd Rokita defends the law, stating it prevents children from harmful content. Similar legal battles are ongoing in Texas, Utah, and Louisiana. The industry challenges laws that impact their operations, highlighting the ongoing debate between protecting minors and free speech rights.
