

Alert: Recall of Canned Tuna Due to Botulism Concerns

Some canned tuna brands from Trader Joe's, Costco, and Walmart have been recalled due to concerns about a dangerous bacterium called *Clostridium botulinum*.



Tri-Union, a seafood company, voluntarily recalled certain canned tuna products because of a faulty "easy open" lid that could lead to contamination.

Consumers are advised not to use the recalled products, even if they seem fine, and to seek medical help if feeling unwell.

Products Affected by the Recall:

- Genova Solid White Tuna in Olive Oil 5.0 oz
- Genova Yellowfin Tuna in Olive Oil 5.0 oz
- Van Camp's Solid Light Tuna in Oil 5.0 oz
