

Alexandra Daddario and Finn Wittrock Shine in New Film

Description

A new movie called "Hershey" will tell the story of how the famous chocolate company was founded. The film will star Finn Wittrock as Milton Hershey and Alexandra Daddario as his wife, Kitty.
