



Alix Earle's 'Hot Mess' Podcast Exits Alex Cooper's Network

Description

Hot mess, indeed.

Alix Earle's podcast "Hot Mess" has recently been discontinued by Alex Cooper's Unwell Network. Reports indicate that SiriusXM will no longer manage advertising for the show, and the Unwell Network has relinquished all rights to "Hot Mess," enabling Earle to pursue new opportunities unencumbered.
