Frank Fritz co-hosted "American Pickers" with Mike Wolfe since 2010, traveling across the US in search of rare treasures. Fritz's dedication to the show earned him the title of 'the bearded charmer.'

The History Channel and the producers of the show paid tribute to Fritz, describing him as a beloved

In addition to his television career, Fritz owned an antique store and was inducted into the Sturgis Motorcycle Museum Hall of Fame in 2019.
