

Apollo 8 astronaut William Anders, renowned for iconic Earthrise photo, tragically killed in plane crash

Description

Former Apollo 8 astronaut William Anders, known for capturing the iconic "Earthrise" photo in 1968, tragically passed away in a plane crash off the San Juan Islands in Washington state. The 90-year-old pilot was flying solo when the incident occurred. His son, retired Air Force Lt. Col. Greg Anders, confirmed the devastating news.

Anders' Earthrise photo, the first color image of Earth from space, significantly impacted how humans viewed the planet, sparking the global environmental movement. His contributions to the space program were immense, including ensuring the success of the Apollo 8 mission, the first human spaceflight to travel to the moon and back.

Despite the risks involved in such missions, Anders highlighted the importance of exploration and the profound impact it had on humanity's perspective. His legacy as an astronaut and pilot will be remembered by many, including NASA Administrator Bill Nelson and Arizona Sen. Mark Kelly, both former astronauts themselves.
