



'Avatar: Fire and Ash' Tops U.K. Home Entertainment Chart

Description

Director James Cameron's film, *Avatar: Fire and Ash*, is number one on the Official Film Chart in the U.K. It has held this place for three weeks, as of April 22.

Hamnet, a film by Universal, is now in second place. It moved up six spots in its tenth week on the chart. Another Universal film, *Wicked: For Good*, is in third place. It also moved up three spots in its sixteenth week.

Wuthering Heights from Warner rose three spots to fourth position. *The Housemaid* by Lionsgate stayed in fifth place.

The Super Mario Bros. Movie jumped seven spots to sixth place. It is in its 105th week on the chart. *Sinners*, another Warner film, dropped five spots to seventh in its 45th week.

New this week is *Reminders of Him*, at ninth place. *One Battle After Another* from Warner fell seven spots to tenth place in its 23rd week.
