



BBC Reporter Alleges Falseness of Kate Middleton Farm Video: 'It's Clearly Not Her'

Description

Confusion and curiosity have **enveloped** the royal family after BBC reporter Sonja McLaughlan suggested a video featuring Princess Kate Middleton might be fake.
