



Bella Hadid apologizes for Adidas SL 72 Munich Olympics campaign.

Description

Supermodel Bella Hadid issued an apology on Monday after facing **backlash** for her involvement in an Adidas ad campaign. The campaign, which featured Hadid promoting the re-release of Adidas' SL 72 sneaker, sparked **controversy** due to its connection to the 1972 Munich Olympics where Palestinian attackers killed 11 Israelis and a German police officer.

In response to the criticism, Hadid expressed **regret**, stating that she was unaware of the sneaker's history and would not have participated if she had known. She emphasized her disappointment with the lack of **sensitivity** in the campaign and apologized for any offense caused.

Adidas also issued an apology, clarifying that they did not intend to draw connections to the tragic events of 1972. The brand expressed regret for the **unintentional** mistake and apologized to the celebrities involved in the campaign as well as communities worldwide.
