



Boeing Starliner Crewed Flight Test on ULA Atlas V

Description

Kennedy Space Center Visitor Complex is gearing up for an exciting event – NASA's Boeing Starliner Crewed Flight Test (CFT) scheduled for June 1, 2024, at 12:25 PM. This milestone launch for NASA's Commercial Crew Program will send two astronauts to the International Space Station aboard Boeing's Starliner spacecraft for the first time.

Following a successful test flight, NASA will certify the spacecraft and systems for regular crew rotation flights to the space station.
