# Bonnie Tyler Hospitalised Following Cardiac Arrest After Surgery

## Description

Singer Bonnie Tyler, known for her hit "Total Eclipse of the Heart," experienced a cardiorespiratory arrest while in Portugal, as reported by local media outlets. The 74-year-old musician was recently admitted to hospital for an emergency intestinal surgery, which her official website confirmed was successful.

Following her surgery, Tyler began recuperating in Faro. However, complications arose when doctors attempted to bring her out of a medically induced coma, leading to a second emergency situation. According to the newspaper *Correio da Manhã*, she is currently in intensive care at Faro Hospital. Medical staff have reportedly initiated antibiotic treatment for a general infection, which developed after her condition deteriorated.

As of Monday, representatives for Tyler had not commented on her status, leaving her precise condition unclear. Guitarist Ed Poole conveyed to fans via Instagram that he had no further updates but expressed hopes for Tyler's recovery.

Reports indicate that Tyler's health issues began during a performance in London. After exhibiting discomfort, she returned to her home in Portugal, where a ruptured appendix was diagnosed, necessitating urgent surgery.

Bonnie Tyler enjoyed significant fame in the 1980s, particularly with her 1983 anthem "Total Eclipse of the Heart," which dominated the Billboard Hot 100 chart. This iconic track continues to resonate, featuring in various television commercials and films, notably the 2003 comedy "Old School."

Looking ahead, Tyler's official website lists a concert scheduled for May 30 in Germany, along with additional performances planned throughout the year.
