This manual process, conducted by our sound team in post-production, aimed to preserve the integrity of their performances rather than alter them."

Additionally, AI played a role in generating architectural imagery for the film's closing sequence. However, Corbet clarified, "Judy Becker and her team did not rely on AI for the buildings; all visuals were meticulously hand-drawn. The memorial video featured background images crafted to resemble subpar digital renderings from the 1980s."

Corbet added, "The narrative of *The Brutalist* delves into the complexities of human experience, and every facet of its production was rooted in human creativity and collaboration. We take immense pride in what our team has achieved."

As the award season approaches, the conversation around AI-generated content in films, including *The Brutalist*, raises critical questions about authenticity and artistic expression.
