

CBS Cancels 'After Midnight'; Taylor Tomlinson Returns to Stand-Up

Description

CBS announced the surprising cancellation of its late-night comedy show "After Midnight" due to host Taylor Tomlinson's decision to focus on her stand-up comedy career full-time. The show, which aired at 12:30 a.m., was introduced in January 2024 as a replacement for "The Late Late Show."

Initially planned for a third season, CBS decided to end "After Midnight" prematurely following Tomlinson's departure. The final episode is set to air in June. Tomlinson, known for her relatable humor and Netflix specials, expressed her desire to return to her roots in stand-up comedy.

The cancellation underscores the challenges late-night TV faces in a changing landscape where streaming services are gaining popularity. CBS's move to end the 12:30 a.m. programming tradition that began in 1995 with "The Late Late Show" signifies a shift in network strategies.

Many late-night hosts, like Trevor Noah and James Corden, have transitioned to new opportunities, reflecting a trend of diversity and flexibility in the industry. With CBS moving away from the late-night format, the future of traditional late-night television remains uncertain.

As networks navigate these changes, the sustainability and direction of late-night TV are being reevaluated in response to evolving viewer preferences.
