



China Focuses on Chatbot Relationships Amid Population Crisis

Description

China is making new rules about AI chatbots. This is because the country has a shrinking population and very low birth rates.

The new rules started on Wednesday. They say chatbots cannot encourage emotional dependence. They cannot form romantic or family-like relationships with young users. If a user is in danger, companies must contact a guardian or an emergency contact.

Many companies, like Alibaba and ByteDance, have already changed their chatbot features. They must now follow these new rules.

Beijing is worried that AI chatbots might stop people from making real-life relationships. Officials also fear that this could lead to social problems like addiction. They want people to focus on real connections instead.

The new rules require chatbots to pass a government review before users can access them. The government can also shut down chatbots they think are unsafe. China's rules are stronger than those in California and New York. These states only require chatbots to remind users they are not human.
