



Chip stocks decline following report of US intentions to increase restrictions on China

Description

ASML, a prominent chip manufacturing equipment company, has been at the center of recent turbulence in the technology stocks market. Concerns about the global computer chip industry have led to a significant sell-off across various stock exchanges worldwide.

The market downturn was triggered by reports suggesting that the Biden administration might tighten restrictions on exports of semiconductor equipment to China. Additionally, comments made by former US President Donald Trump implying that Taiwan, the largest chip producer, should take responsibility for its own defense further exacerbated the situation.

In response to these developments, the tech-heavy Nasdaq index closed 2.7% lower in the US, while chip stocks also experienced significant declines in Europe and Asia. Companies like TSMC and Tokyo Electron saw their stock prices drop, with Nvidia and AMD also experiencing significant losses. ASML, a chip-making machinery manufacturer, saw its shares tumble by almost 11% in Europe.

Despite the immediate market reactions, experts like Marco Mezger from Neumonda remain optimistic about the long-term prospects of the semiconductor industry. While geopolitical tensions continue to impact the market, the overall trend for the industry remains positive.
