



Classic Dino GTS Ferrari, previously owned by Led Zeppelin's manager, is set for auction.

Description

Once belonging to Led Zeppelin's reputable manager, Peter Grant, a vintage Ferrari 246 Dino GTS from the esteemed year of 1973 is poised to descend under the scrutinizing gaze of enthusiast bidders at an exciting auction scheduled for later this month.
