

Court fines Musk site for unauthorized return: SEO alert.

Description

Brazil fined Elon Musk's companies because some users in the country briefly accessed the social media platform X, even though it was banned. Users in Brazil went to the site after X changed its servers in the country, but the company said it was unintentional and blocked access again later. A court fined the firm for breaking the ban. The company switched back to its old provider, detected by the ABRINT internet provider association. X and Cloudflare have not confirmed the move, but a judge fined X and Starlink for every day X operates in Brazil. It's unclear if the court can enforce the payment. X said it was an accident that some users accessed the site and is working with the government to return. Some thought it was on purpose. ABRINT said X moved to servers hosted by Cloudflare, using dynamic IP addresses harder to block. Although some experts think Cloudflare can help enforce the ban, others are frustrated with the situation in Brazil.
