



Critical Ultimatum: Doge orders US federal workers to decide

Description

US government employees recently received an email asking them to list their achievements from the previous week or face resignation. This email, part of President Trump's plan to streamline the federal workforce, was sent by Elon Musk, head of the Department of Government Efficiency (Doge), following an announcement on social media.

The email requested employees to summarize their accomplishments in five bullet points by Monday, without sharing classified information. The Office of Personnel Management (OPM), responsible for human resources in the federal government, confirmed the authenticity of the email and emphasized the importance of efficiency and accountability in the workforce.
