Popular stand-up comic and actor Richard Lewis has passed away at the age of 76. Lewis was a prominent figure in the world of comedy, known for his self-deprecating humor and his acclaimed appearances on numerous television shows, the celebrated amongst them being "Anything but Love" and "Curb Your Enthusiasm". He once joked about him being a hypochondriac to such an extent that he feared giving himself a disease. Yet, behind his humor was a person who had battled numerous personal and health challenges with strength and courage. His death, thus, marked the loss of a comedy legend and a true artist who made millions laugh through his honest and unique brand of humor. His remarkable contributions to the world of comedy will be fondly remembered and missed by his fans all over the world.
