

Current Net Worth of the Disgraced Rapper Revealed

Description

As reports circulate that Kanye West and Bianca Censori may be heading for a divorce, <u>TMZ</u> has revealed that the couple does not have a prenuptial agreement in place.

Last month, West asserted his net worth to be an impressive \$2.7 billion, attributing this figure largely to his "music portfolio" and "sole ownership of the Yeezy brand." However, <u>Forbes</u> countered this claim, estimating his actual fortune at approximately \$400 million.

On Saturday, TMZ reported that the absence of a prenup might not favor Censori, explaining that "Kanye has reportedly lost money since their marriage. In California, assets and debts are split evenly, meaning she could potentially owe him money."

The speculation surrounding a possible separation intensified earlier this week, particularly after West was seen promoting swastika-themed T-shirts and making antisemitic remarks on social media.

His tirade began post-2025 Grammys, where he generated significant backlash by walking the red carpet with Censori, who wore a revealing see-through dress. An insider shared, "She's had enough. The swastika shirt was the breaking point. She told him she cannot be associated with that."

Despite claims from his representative denying any divorce plans, West continues to post controversial statements, raising eyebrows and concerns over his mental state.
