



# Dana Carvey Apologizes to Sharon Stone for Controversial SNL Skit

## Description

Sharon Stone, the acclaimed Hollywood actress, recently graced the podcast "Fly on the Wall," hosted by renowned comedic talents Dana Carvey and David Spade. The conversation spanned Stone's illustrious career, focusing particularly on her experience hosting "Saturday Night Live" (SNL) in late April 1992, following her success in "Basic Instinct."
