

## Daughter's Response to Viral, Harsh Obituary Sparks Outrage

#### **Description**

A woman from Maine is shedding light on the controversial obituary she penned for her mother, which garnered international attention last month. Christina Novak's concise four-sentence obituary for her mother, Florence "Flo" Harrelson, was published in the Kennebec Journal on Aug. 30. Despite seeking approval from her mother's twin sister before submitting the obituary, Novak never expected it to gain global attention. Interestingly, Novak comes from a family accustomed to media attention, as she is the niece of William "Wild Bill" Davenport, known for his appearances on the reality show "Maine Cabin Masters." Davenport passed away last year at 73 and received a much longer and more positive obituary.

In conclusion, the obituary serves as a stark portrayal of a complex mother-daughter relationship that has captivated audiences worldwide, shedding light on dark family dynamics that often remain hidden.
