



Dayton Children's Hospital to Rename Campus After £40m Donation

Description

Dayton Children's Hospital in Dayton received a \$40 million donation from Tom Golisano. The hospital will rename its main campus to "Dayton Children's Golisano Comprehensive Care Campus."

This donation will help many children and families. Jena Pado, from the hospital, said this money will improve what families experience at the hospital. The aim is to intervene early and support children's health.

Tom Golisano is a businessman. He created a company called Paychex. He is worth between \$4.8 billion and \$6.9 billion, according to Forbes. Golisano said it is important for children to get the right care before problems become serious.

The money will help new projects. These projects include expanding primary care, improving mental health services, and bringing care closer to communities. Deborah Feldman, the hospital's outgoing CEO, said they want to change healthcare to help children earlier.

This donation is part of a larger plan. Dayton Children's Hospital will join the Golisano Children's Alliance. This group helps hospitals improve children's healthcare. Golisano wants to support 40 hospitals in total. More partnerships will be announced soon.
