
Debate ignited by Tatler magazine's portrait of Catherine, Princess of Wales

Description

A controversial new portrait of Catherine, the Princess of Wales, has sparked debate online. The painting, created by artist Hannah Uzor, features on the cover of Tatler magazine's July issue.
