

Decades-Old Doorstop Rock Valued Over \$1 Million!

Description

They say one person's trash is another person's treasure. A 3.5-kilogram stone, used as a doorstop for many years, is a real treasure.

This stone was found in a stream in Romania by an elderly woman. She took it home and used it to keep her door open.

Later, she learned that her “doorstop” was one of the biggest pieces of amber in the world. Experts say it is worth around €1 million (about \$1.1 million).
