



Delaware Judge Reassigns Elon Musk Cases After Emoji Dispute

Description

A judge in Delaware has decided to remove herself from several shareholder lawsuits against Tesla CEO Elon Musk following accusations of bias from his legal team. Chancellor Kathaleen McCormick, who presides over the Delaware Chancery Court, announced on Monday that she will reassign three pertinent lawsuits to different judges.

This decision came after Musk's attorneys filed a motion last week claiming that McCormick and a staff member had reacted positively on LinkedIn to posts critical of Musk. In her court filing, McCormick refuted these allegations, asserting that she had not supported any LinkedIn posts regarding Musk. She maintained that the basis for the recusal request was misleading, stating, "I am not biased against the defendants in these actions."

While McCormick opted not to formally recuse herself from the cases, she felt that the intense media scrutiny surrounding her involvement could negatively influence the justice process. She expressed confidence in the abilities of the other vice chancellors to manage these cases effectively.

Musk's legal team argued that McCormick had reacted to a post celebrating his defeat in a separate lawsuit, while also noting that a member of her staff engaged with another post that criticised Musk. In her response, McCormick claimed she did not remember seeing the contested post and reported suspicious activity to LinkedIn.

The lawsuits in question include allegations that Musk prioritised personal benefit over that of Tesla shareholders and claims that the company's board allowed actions contrary to a settlement with the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC). Musk has denied any wrongdoing in these matters. The next steps will involve the newly assigned judges taking over the cases.
