



Disney, Universal Ready for Hurricane Helene.

Description

Dr. Andrew Forrest, founder and Executive Chair of Fortescue, talks about the possible connection between Hurricane Helene's strength and climate change on 'Varney & Co.'

Hurricane Helene, a Category 3 storm, is approaching Florida, causing concern for Walt Disney World Resort and Universal Orlando. The National Hurricane Center (NHC) has warned of a potential "unsurvivable" storm surge.

Both theme parks are situated in central Florida and have implemented operational changes in response to the impending storm. Universal Orlando's theme parks will close at their usual time, and CityWalk will close early at 8 p.m. Hotels are focused on guest safety and comfort.

Meanwhile, Disney World is closely monitoring the hurricane, ensuring the safety of guests and staff. Some experiences and attractions have been affected, such as water parks and special events like "Mickey's Not-So-Scary Halloween Party." Magic Kingdom extended its hours to 8 p.m. on Thursday for guests to enjoy before the storm.

Residents in the predicted path of Hurricane Helene are urged to complete preparations for potential impacts. Florida Governor Ron DeSantis has declared a state of emergency for 61 counties to ensure necessary resources are available.
