# Don Cheadle and Ayo Edebiri Debut on Broadway

## Description

In the Broadway revival of "Proof," Don Cheadle portrays a mathematical genius grappling with mental health difficulties, while Ayo Edebiri plays his daughter, who faces her own challenges. This marks their first collaboration in theatre, and Edebiri expressed her excitement at the opportunity to work alongside an actor she admires.

Cheadle and Edebiri have developed a father-daughter dynamic outside the performance. Cheadle often checks in with Edebiri, concerned about her late-night texts as they prepare for their nightly shows. The plot of "Proof" revolves around Catherine, a young woman who sacrifices her aspirations to care for her father, Robert, an academic.

The themes of the play explore familial relationships and the exchanges of care between parents and children. Edebiri noted how participating in "Proof" has prompted her to reassess her own relationship with her parents, reflecting on the inevitable roles people assume as they age.

Edebiri has gained recognition through her performance in the acclaimed series "The Bear," which earned her an Emmy Award. Cheadle, a veteran of over 50 films, has portrayed a diverse array of characters, from a serious lawyer to a hero in "Hotel Rwanda," which gained him an Oscar nomination.

Both actors are making their Broadway debuts with "Proof," alongside producers Barack and Michelle Obama. Cheadle articulated the exhilarating yet nerve-wracking experience of taking to the stage, likening it to the thrill of a roller coaster just before the ride begins.
