

Dwayne Johnson and Chris Evans' 'Red One' Surpasses \$100M Worldwide

Description

Amazon MGM Studios' highly anticipated Christmas action film, *Red One*, featuring Dwayne Johnson and Chris Evans, is poised to surpass the remarkable milestone of **\$100 million** at the global box office as of tomorrow.

Although the film debuted below projected expectations in the U.S. and Canada with a weekend haul of \$32.1 million, it demonstrated substantial performance on Tuesday, generating \$3.1 million—an impressive 87% increase from Monday's \$1.66 million. This Tuesday figure closely approximates the \$3.4 million that Johnson's *Rampage* earned on its inaugural Tuesday; however, *Rampage* accomplished its \$100 million domestic gross over an extended theatrical release. Additionally, *Red One*'s Tuesday performance outpaced *IF*'s Tuesday figure of \$2.86 million. Wednesday brought in \$1.4 million, while projections for today estimate \$1.2 million. Presently, the film's overseas total for the \$200 million to \$250 million production stands at \$55 million, with Warner Bros. managing the international territories. Initially, Amazon intended to release the film exclusively on its streaming platform but subsequently transitioned to a theatrical release. According to insiders, if *Red One* can recoup its global print and advertising costs estimated at \$100 million, it will be considered a success for the platform.

This weekend, *Red One* will encounter significant competition from Universal's *Wicked Part One*, starring Ariana Grande and Cynthia Erivo, and Paramount's *Gladiator II*, directed by Ridley Scott and featuring Paul Mescal. *Wicked* has already conducted fan screenings on Monday and Wednesday, with expectations of a domestic opening weekend gross between \$130 million and \$150 million. Meanwhile, *Gladiator II* is anticipated to exceed \$60 million in its debut. Recent presales for *Wicked* reportedly reached an impressive \$30 million. Analysts hope that *Red One* may experience a relatively modest decline of 55% in its second weekend, translating to approximately \$14.4 million in revenue.

The film has garnered an A- CinemaScore, which is promising for its long-term viability despite mixed critical reception. Historically, Christmas-themed films released prior to the COVID-19 pandemic have demonstrated multiples ranging from three to five times their opening box office returns. However, this trend may be complicated by the existence of a streaming release on the horizon.



Notably, *Polar Express*, which was initially perceived as a failure upon its 2004 release—earning \$23.2million despite a production cost of \$170 million—ultimately achieved a staggering sevenfold return from its domestic opening, culminating in a total of \$162.7 million from its first run, bolstered by an A+CinemaScore. Directed by Robert Zemeckis and featuring Tom Hanks, the CGI animated film later amassedan additional \$26.8 million during theatrical re-releases, resulting in a lifetime gross of \$189.5 million in theU.S. and Canada. On a global scale, the adaptation of Chris Van Allsburg's children's book has amassed animpressive \$318.3 million, further enriched by steady revenues from subsequent linear televisionbroadcasts and streaming. At the time of its debut, *Polar Express* faced criticism for its experimental motion-capture animation, which was considered unsettling; however, perceptions have evolved significantly overthe years.
