

Elon Musk Slams Trump Adviser Navarro as 'Moron' over Tesla Comment

Description

Elon Musk recently criticized President Donald Trump's trade adviser, Peter Navarro, calling him a "moron" and "dumber than a sack of bricks" on social media. This came after Navarro made comments about Tesla, describing it as a "car assembler" instead of a manufacturer due to its use of foreign-made parts.

Navarro's remarks were in the context of Trump's tariff policy, where he emphasized the importance of manufacturing in the US. Musk quickly refuted Navarro's claims by citing a 2023 article that highlighted Tesla's high percentage of US-made parts, making it one of the most vertically integrated auto manufacturers in America.

Despite Technology industry analyst Dan Ives pointing out that Tesla sources most of its parts from outside the US, the company remains less exposed to tariffs compared to other US car makers like GM and Ford.

While Trump's tariffs have caused global stock market fluctuations, Musk expressed concerns about the potential impact on Tesla's supply chain and global operations. Similarly, billionaire fund manager Bill Ackman called for a pause on tariffs to prevent "major global economic disruption."

Navarro, known for his loyalty to Trump, has faced criticism in the past for his involvement in efforts to overturn the 2020 election and is considered a key architect of Trump's tariff policy.
