
Examining Prince Andrew's Interview About Jeffrey Epstein: A Deep Dive by NPR

Description

In a recent interview, Sam McAlister, a former BBC Newsnight booker, shared her experience securing what would become an infamous interview with Prince Andrew **amidst** his connection to **convicted** sex offender Jeffrey Epstein. The interview, which has been dramatized in Netflix's new film, Scoop, took nearly a year to secure.
