Description

On a different note, the notion of a "Blue Moon" does not imply a blue-colored moon. Instead, it commonly signifies the occurrence of two full moons within a single month or the occurrence of four full moons between a solstice and equinox, with the third being labeled as a seasonal Blue Moon.

As we delve into the historical origins and cultural significance of full moons, the "Sturgeon Moon" emerges as a unique moniker for the August full moon. This title pays homage to the abundance of lake sturgeon, a once vital food source for Native Americans and settlers in the Great Lakes region during the month of August. Despite the dwindling population of lake sturgeon in modern times, the association with the "Sturgeon Moon" endures as a testament to ancient traditions.
