



Experts Weigh In on Anthropic Mythos Cybersecurity Risks

Description

Anthropic, a tech company, announced this week that it will not release its new AI model, Mythos. The company has concerns about cybersecurity. They believe Mythos is powerful enough that even people without expertise could misuse it to attack major operating systems.

Instead, Anthropic will allow 11 selected organisations, including Google and Microsoft, to access a version called Claude Mythos Preview. This decision is part of what they call "Project Glasswing."

The announcement raised alarms quickly. The Chair of the Federal Reserve, Jerome Powell, and other top officials from U.S. banks met to discuss the risks involved. Some experts worry about the cybersecurity issues, while others doubt the excitement around Mythos. They think it is not significantly better than existing models and may just be clever marketing.

Many voices are in the discussion. AI expert Gary Marcus said the fears are exaggerated. Yann LeCun, another AI leader, thinks the hype is overblown. Meanwhile, some believe the advancements in AI will help those defending against cyber threats more than those planning attacks. As the situation develops, experts continue to provide their insights on the matter.
