

# Famous musician expresses regret over missed assassination attempt on Trump, faces backlash

## **Description**

It has been a tumultuous few days for Kyle Gass, one half of the renowned rock band Tenacious D, after he made a controversial comment during a Sunday show regarding Donald Trump's assassination attempt. Gass expressed his wish that the shooter had not missed, sparking outrage and shock among fans and even his own bandmate, Jack Black. In response to the backlash, the band made the difficult decision to cancel the remainder of their tour, including a stop in State College.

Following the incident, reports emerged that Gass had been dropped by his talent agency, Michael Greene of Greene & Associates Talent Agency. The repercussions of his ill-advised comment continued as Australian senator Ralph Babet called for the group to be deported from the country.

In an attempt to rectify the situation, Gass took to Instagram to issue a heartfelt apology, acknowledging his mistake and expressing regret for the pain his words had caused. Jack Black also addressed the controversy on social media, denouncing hate speech and political violence.

The incident has placed a cloud over the future of Tenacious D, with Black revealing that all creative plans are currently on hold. Despite the difficulties, the duo, who have been performing together since 1994, remain hopeful that they will be able to move past this controversy and continue to bring their music to fans around the world.
