



Final Destination Bloodlines Shatters \$100 Million Opening Weekend!

Description

"Final Destination Bloodlines" had a strong start at the box office. It made \$51 million from 74 countries in its first weekend.

This R-rated horror movie from Warner Bros. and New Line also earned \$51 million in the United States. This means it has a total of \$102 million worldwide. This film did much better than previous movies in the series, which began with "Final Destination" in 2000. Because of good reviews and positive word-of-mouth, it is expected to become the highest-grossing film in the series, surpassing "The Final Destination" from 2011, which made \$186 million worldwide.

Directed by Adam Stein and Zach Lipovsky, "Final Destination Bloodlines" continues the franchise's tradition of showing creative and shocking deaths. The story revolves around a family that faces deadly events because their mother survived a terrible incident 50 years ago.
