## Five Mario Kart Habits Players Should Quit Now

### Description

Mario Kart World has been out for over a year. It offers new game modes, unique character costumes, and a large map. Some players might have bad habits that stop them from winning races.

If you have a Nintendo Switch 2 and are new to Mario Kart, there are common mistakes you can fix. First, turn off Smart Steering. This feature helps you stay on track, but it can also slow you down. You can do this in the settings.

Also, don't ignore the smaller speed boosts. Use drifting to gain Mini-Boosts and slipstreaming to speed up by following another player closely. Rail grinding can help too. You need to jump on the rails using the R/ZR button.

Next, remember to collect coins. They improve your maximum speed. Try to keep 20 coins during a race. You lose coins when hit, so watch for coins dropped by other cars. Finally, don't use items right away. Save them for better moments.

Practice in Free Roam mode. It helps you learn and collect coins without the pressure of a race.
