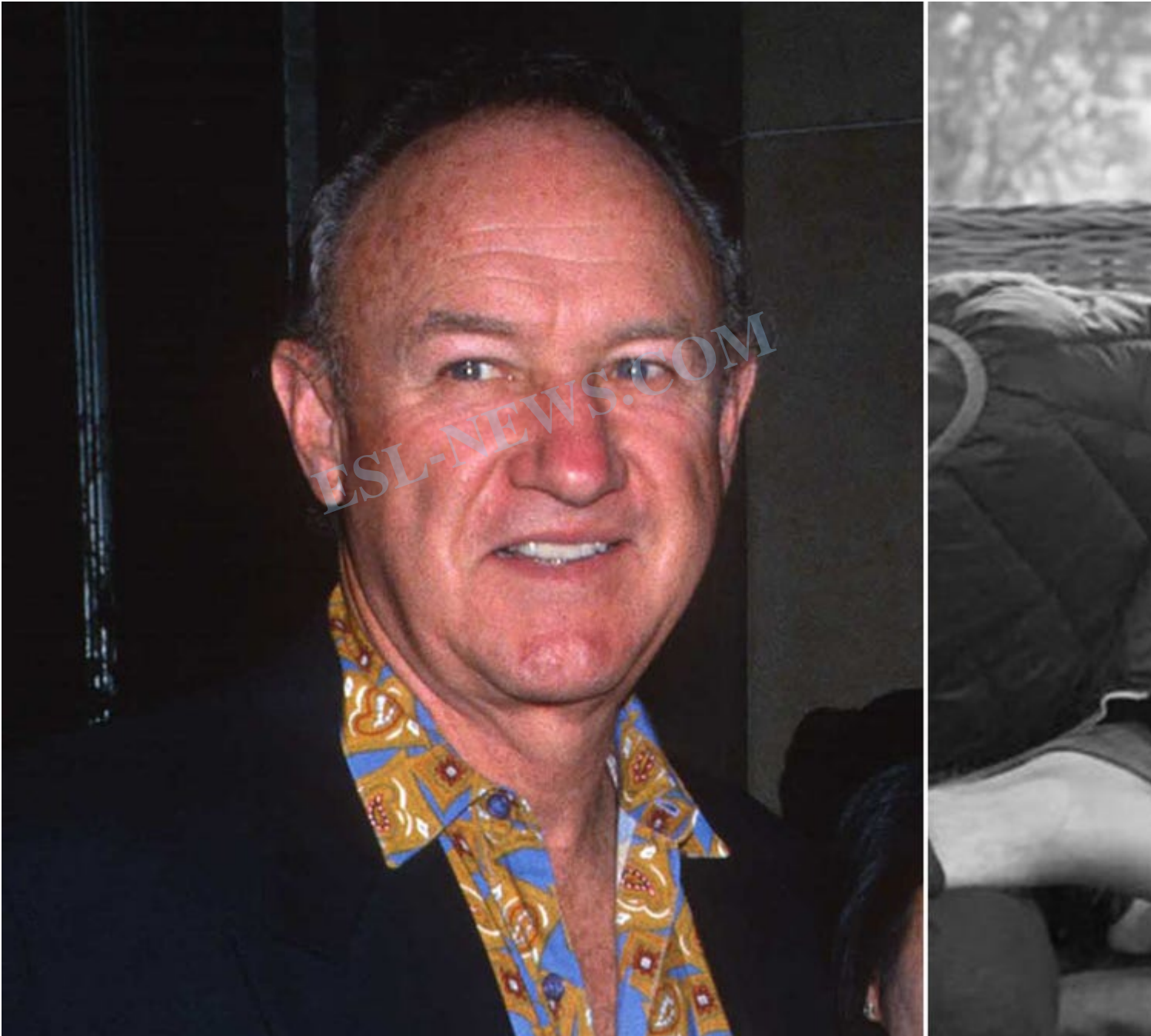

Gene Hackman's Death Causes Revealed; Luxembourg's Prince Frederik, 22, Passes
