

'Genuinely worried' Meghan Markle has reached out to Kate Middleton 'through back channels': source

As whispers concerning the health of the Princess of Wales swirl wildly amidst the turbulence generated by her photo-editing spectacle, Meghan Markle has taken the initiative to extend an offering of solace to her distant sister-in-law, or so says a source privy to the matter.
