

Google is showing fewer AI Overviews in Search results

Description

A new report has found that AI Overviews are appearing in less than 10% of Google search queries, showing a significant decrease in visibility. Google launched AI Overviews for all search users in the US just over two months ago, but has since scaled back the project due to viral errors caused by the AI. Data from BrightEdge reveals that AI Overviews are now only showing up in around 7% of searches, down from 11% at the start of the month. The report also notes a decrease in AI Overviews appearing in education, ecommerce, and entertainment-related searches. Anecdotal evidence suggests that AI Overviews are hardly showing up at all, even in queries that used to prompt them. Overall, users are experiencing a decrease in AI Overviews on Google Search, with many preferring the search engine without them. Have you noticed the decline in AI Overviews?
