



High Potential Season 3 Confirmed, Showrunner Todd Harthan Exits

Description

ABC has confirmed the renewal of "High Potential" for a third season, according to reports. This decision comes amid the departure of Todd Harthan, the series showrunner, who is leaving to focus on a live-action adaptation of "Eragon" for Disney+. A new showrunner will be appointed in due course.
