



Influencer Clavicular Arrested in Battery Case Amid Everglades Probe

Description

An online streamer known as Clavicular was arrested by Fort Lauderdale police on a battery charge on Friday. His real name is Braden Eric Peters, and the charge relates to an incident in Osceola County, near Orlando.

On February 2, police received a report about a battery at an Airbnb in Kissimmee. A 19-year-old woman said that a 24-year-old woman, Violet Marie Lentz, attacked her. The fight took place in a home rented by Peters, who is 20 years old.

The sheriff's office reported that Peters started the fight and shared it on social media to gain attention. When police arrived, neither Peters nor Lentz talked to them about the incident.

Investigators continued their work by talking to witnesses and examining video evidence. After this, the authorities issued an arrest warrant for Peters for misdemeanor battery and criminal conspiracy, which means planning to commit a crime together. A warrant was also issued for Lentz.

Peters was arrested by the Fort Lauderdale Police Department, but Lentz remains at large. Additionally, the Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission investigates reports that Peters shot an alligator in the Everglades.
