

Instagram Removes Recommended Posts Tool

Description

Instagram is testing a new feature that allows users to remove all the content suggested to them. This "reset" tool will soon be available worldwide, giving users the option to clean their feed of algorithmic recommendations. However, Instagram clarifies that over time, the recommendations will become personalized again.

In efforts to enhance user wellbeing, Instagram has introduced various new features. These include safety measures launched in October and new teen accounts in September. Ofcom, the UK media regulator, has acknowledged these efforts but believes more action is necessary to ensure social media safety.

Tech companies are being urged to make significant changes before the UK's Online Safety Act takes full effect. This act will require major sites and apps to provide users with more control over their online experience. Some feel the act might not be stringent enough and advocate for additional restrictions, such as limiting mobile phone use among young people.

Meta, the parent company of Instagram, states that the new feature will allow users, including teens, to reset their recommendations easily. By selecting "reset suggested content" in their preferences, users can unfollow accounts and refresh their feeds. This move aligns with the upcoming implementation of the Online Safety Act, which will hold tech companies accountable for monitoring illegal content online.
