



Jack Black's band Tenacious D cancels tour following backlash over comments on Trump assassination attempt

Description

Tenacious D Cancels Tour After Controversy

American comedy rock band Tenacious D has decided to cancel the remaining tour dates following a controversial incident involving band member Kyle Gass. The backlash began after Gass made a comment that seemed to reference a recent assassination attempt on former US President Donald Trump.
