



'Jailed Diddy' Faces 11th Accuser as Trial Looms

Description

Hip-hop star Sean "Diddy" Combs is in trouble with the law. He is in custody waiting for his trial. The charges against him are very serious. They include racketeering and sex trafficking. If he is found guilty, he could go to jail for life.

Combs' arrest came after several people accused him of sexual assault and violence. One of them is Thalia Graves. She says Combs and his bodyguard hurt her in 2001. They also filmed the incident.
