



Jane's Addiction's Perry Farrell and Dave Navarro Clash Onstage

Description

Following an onstage altercation between Perry Farrell and Dave Navarro during a recent Jane's Addiction concert, the band has issued an apologetic statement to their fans. In an Instagram post from the band's official account, they took responsibility for the incident that occurred on September 13 and announced the cancellation of their upcoming show in Bridgeport, with refunds being provided to ticket holders.
