



Jesse Eisenberg's Struggle on Set: A Real Pain Experience

Description

During the filming of their new movie, "A Real Pain," Jesse Eisenberg felt humbled by his co-star Kieran Culkin. Eisenberg, who wrote and directed the film, admitted to feeling like a novice filmmaker when Culkin challenged his directing style on the first day of shooting. Culkin, known for his role on "Succession," preferred to be filmed in a more natural, documentary-style approach, rather than sticking to a set mark. Despite Eisenberg's initial embarrassment, he soon realized Culkin's method brought a refreshing and lively dynamic to the scenes.
