



Joaquin Phoenix encounters his ideal adversary in Joker: Folie à Deux teaser

Description

The Oscar-winning actor Joaquin Phoenix is returning to his acclaimed portrayal of Arthur Fleck in the sequel to the 2019 film *Joker*, entitled "Joker: Folie à Deux".
