# Justin Baldoni Updates Lawsuit Against Blake Lively Following New Evidence Uncovered

## Description

There is also a timeline of over 150 pages in the lawsuit. It shows Blake's alleged plan to damage Justin's reputation from January 1, 2019.

Blake tried to get Justin's lawsuit against her dismissed. But this did not happen. Now the case is ongoing. More coverage on this lawsuit will be given soon.
